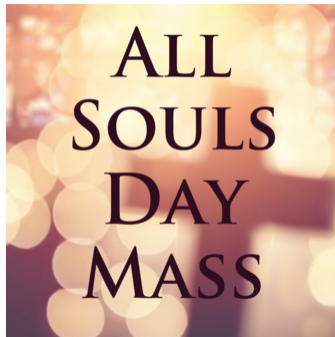

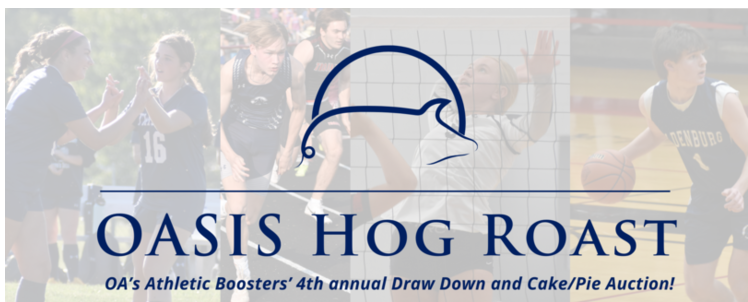

April 8, 2024 | Solar Eclipse | School will be Closed

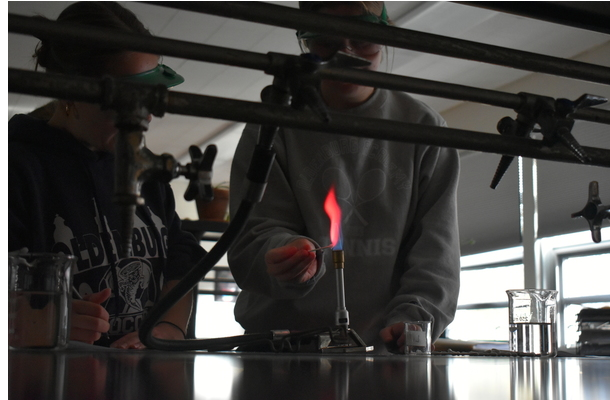
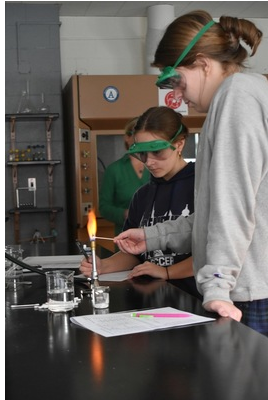
The Department of Homeland Security has recommended that all schools in the line of totality close on **April 8**.
