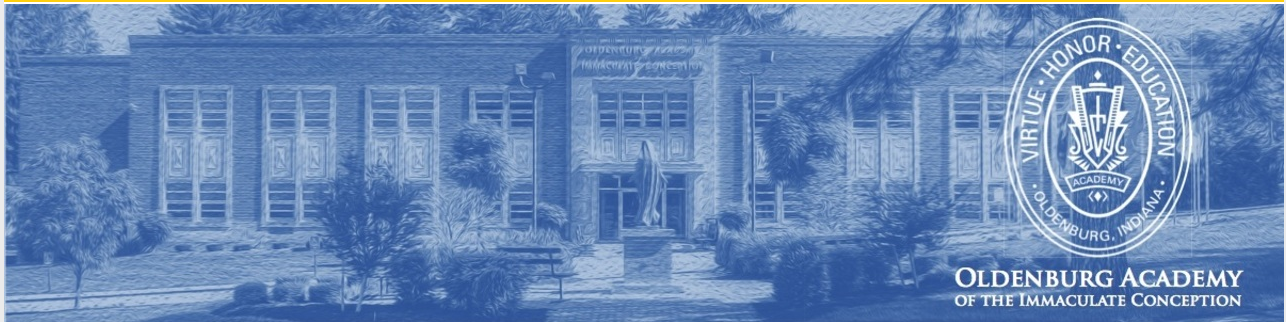

November 11, 2023 | 8:30 - 11:30 AM

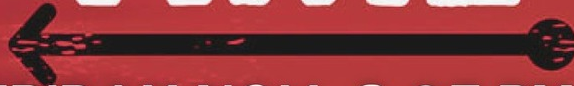

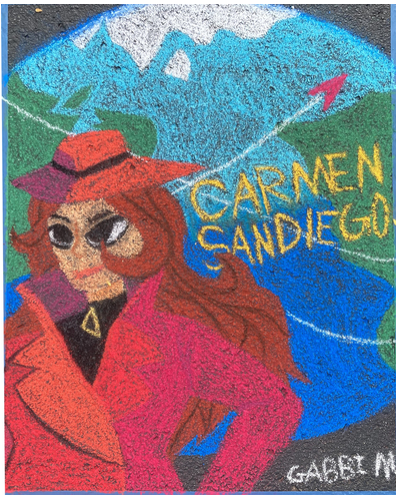
